
Spatial and digital integration and concentration of (sharing) mobility offers

> ... as a contribution to **reducing** the degree of **motorisation** and the **space** available **for private motor vehicles**



Strategic objectives

- enabling multimodal and seamless mobility through diverse, demand-oriented mobility offers
- reducing car density in order to free up public spaces for flexible uses
- increasing the accessibility of urban residential neighbourhoods and thereby contribute to reducing mobility poverty



Mo.Hub

A station in public space with ...



Developed by and for residents of the neighbourhood in cocreation with experts

e.g. cargo-bikes, bike trailer, e-scooter, e-car, short distance to public transport ... e.g. "Grätzloase" with green elements and seating furniture

Cooperative and neighbourhood-based approach

- to ensure demand-oriented service provision
- to test cost-efficient models for sharing with new task sharing
- to increase user acceptance



- Iterative process using quantitative and qualitative criteria for site definiton within the districts
- Coordination with Wiener Linien and local politics
- Formal submission processes and adaptation (e.g. to construction works)

- Initial Activation: recruitung of interested locals for co-creating a Mo.Hub
- Co-Creation: developing and designing a Mo.Hub
- On-going Activation: recruiting of (potential) users




Learnings

First results



Learnings

- consideration of different interests and local conditions within the site definition as
- lack of institutional and legal conditions for (temporary) implementation of mobility hubs in Vienna
- participative process design contradicts current formal approval processes
- High interest of residents regarding the idea and potential results, but low engagement in co-creation
- building upon existing local initiatives and infrastructure

- Operating the Mo.Hubs
 - 6 months pilot operation
 - Ongoing evaluation different perspectives on the Mo.Hub (users, residents, ...)
