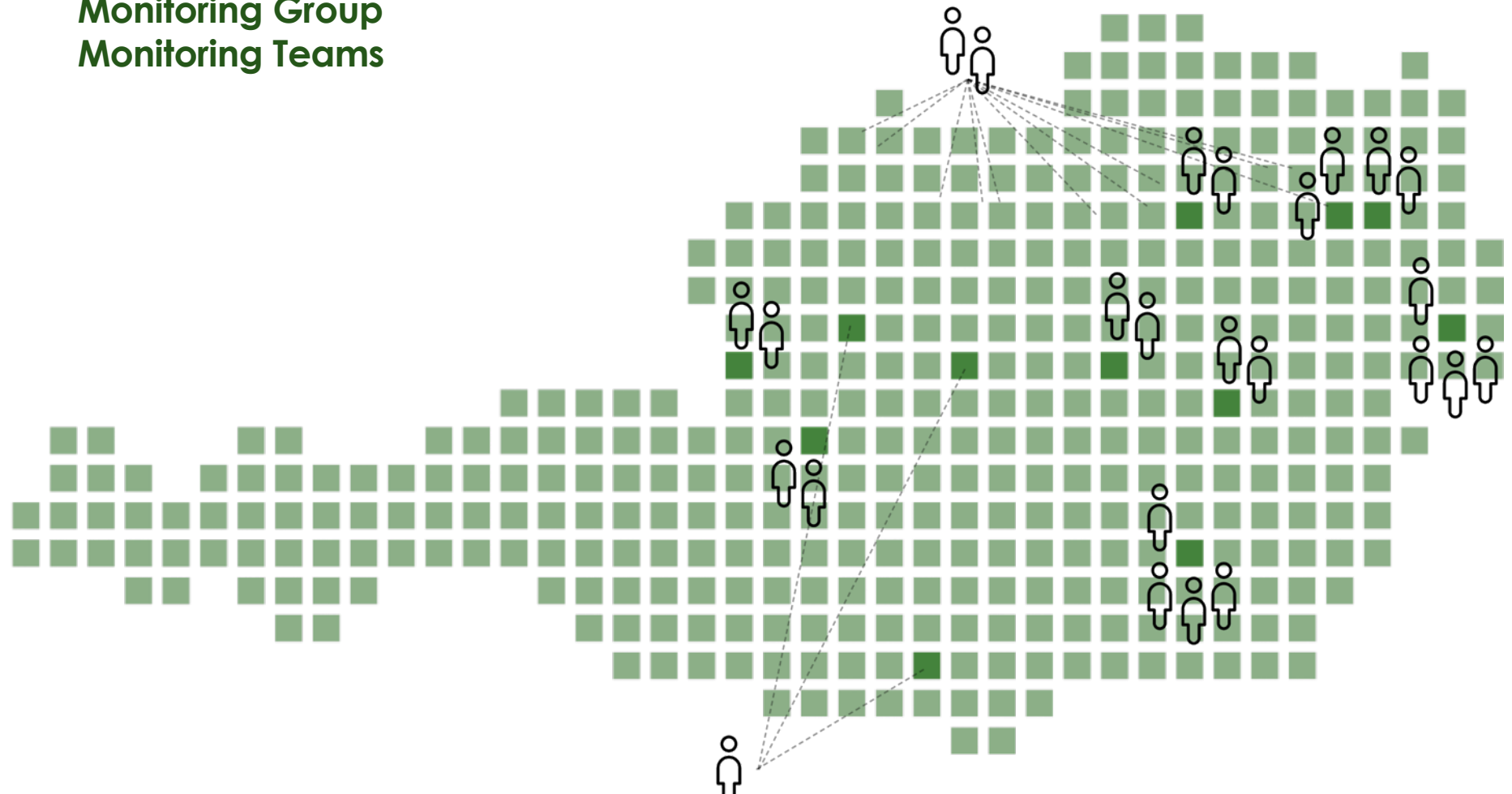




Preventive Monitoring History

- 2007 Establishment of a monitoring group by the Austrian ICOMOS National Committee
- 2008 General Assembly - Quebec, Canada: Establishment of a working group "Preventive Monitoring" 2010: Establishment of the monitoring group of the ICOMOS National Committee Germany
- 2011 World Heritage Expert Meeting in Dakar: Discussion on the inclusion of Preventive Monitoring in the Operational Guide Lines
- 2017 General Assembly New Delhi: Discussion on the Development of an ICOMOS Methodology on Preventive Monitoring
- 2019 Revised version of the Principles on Monitoring, ICOMOS Germany
- 2021 Publication of Monitoring Manual ICOMOS Austria

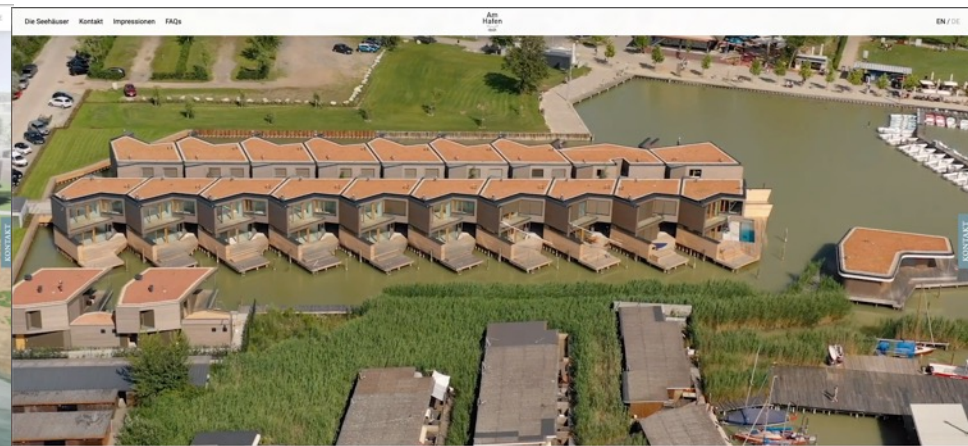
